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Introduction

Stadium Taranaki is Taranaki's premier outdoor sporting and entertainment venue, located in the suburb of Westown, a short distance from New Plymouth's central business district.

With a rich history, Stadium Taranaki has successfully hosted numerous high-profile events, including:

Stadium Taranaki fully reopened in May 2025 after the completion of the East Stand now named TSB Stand and the renovation of the West Stand now the Fisher Funds Stand.

Venue capacity for a Sporting event will be approximately 21,000 increased to around 23,000 with temporary seats and for a concert, the capacity will be 25,000+.



Our vision is to become the best regional stadium in New Zealand with a regular program of national and international sports and entertainment events. This will be achieved by providing a quality experience for event promoters, participants and spectators, through superior event facilities, presentation and management: and through the early adoption and smart use of technology.

One way the Stadium is leading the way on inclusivity and accessibility is by becoming the first stadium in Australasia to implement the Auracast hearing loop system.

Auracast is a Bluetooth Technology that broadcasts to a person's hearing aid or earphones directly. This therefore allows individuals to manage volume of music, presenters and commentators to their own required levels. The stadium also provides belt packs available for patrons, ensuring accessibility for all attendees, not solely those with hearing aids.

With the completion of the Stadium, the team continues to explore opportunities to host new activities and events, while also working alongside key ongoing franchises.



Stadium Taranaki redevelopment

Stadium Taranaki fully re-opened in May 2025 after an extensive rebuild and renovation. These included:

- TSB Stand moved 8m closer to the main field, providing players, participants, and spectators with an incredible atmosphere.
- A cultural narrative for the stadium in collaboration with local iwi, Ngati Te Whiti
- New Hybrid playing turf enabling increased use
- LED Floodlights



Our venue

- Four patron entrance gates.
- Two covered stands and two open terraces (both standing and seated) which allows for various ticket types and price options.
- Private use of on-site parking available including disability spaces and Sky TV allocation if required, as well as on-street parking surrounding the venue for event goers.

TSB Stand

Level 1 – Concourse

With its bold industrial aesthetic and raw architectural charm, the concourse offers an unforgettable dynamic space for expos, trade shows and welcoming drinks and nibbles.

Level 2 – Corporate Lounge

Host an unforgettable event in the new TSB Stand with the Corporate Lounge, offering a maximum seated capacity of 350 pax and a maximum cocktail style capacity of 400. A unique versatile space perfect for large scale events from conferences and personal celebrations to functions/dinners.

Outdoor corporate seating

Located in the middle of the TSB Stand above the players tunnel are 64 padded seats that provide prime viewing for all bookings and events.

Suite 1 and Suite 2

With 2 large suites, accommodating up to 80 guests each, there are a variety of options to best suit your event needs. For smaller groups, each suite can easily be divided into two.

Booths 1 and Booths 2

An alternative corporate room, for smaller or VIP groups there are two indoor booths located above the grandstand near the halfway line. Each has a maximum capacity of 10 people.

On the west coast of the North Island located halfway between Auckland and Wellington, New Plymouth is nestled between picture perfect Taranaki Maunga/Mount Taranaki and the Tasman Sea and is easily accessed by using Air New Zealand's domestic service and by road via major state highways.
